Duties

- 1. Assign workload for shift
- 2. Assist with Quality Improvement Program (Monitoring and Reporting Indicators)
- 3. Oversee day-to-day operation of the shift in supervising Cardiology staff and student development
- 4. Ensure all physician orders are processed
- 5. Enhance expression and promote understanding of the mission and philosophy of the Cardiopulmonary Department and Oroville Hospital
- 6. Maintain optimum supervisor staff relationship and promote an environment conductive to maximizing staff image and self-respect
- 7. Monitor overtime and cost effective use of supplies, equipment and staff
- 8. Low census staff according to departmental policy
- 9. Act as a liaison (buffer) between technicians, technologist, nurses and physician
- 10. Check and order supplies

Qualifications

- 1. Graduate from a two year cardiovascular program or an equivalent level of education or experience
- 2. Certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support (CPR)
- 3. Must be able to maintain optimum shift supervisor relationship and respect
- 4. Be able to walk 4-6 hours a day
- 5. Must be able to lift maximum of 20 pounds
- 6. Must have a high degree of manual dexterity

Lifting Requirements

Sedentary- generally not more than 10 lbs. maximum and occasionally lifting and/or carrying such articles as ledgers, files and small items.
