Job Summary

The Nurse Manager is responsible for planning, organizing, implementing and evaluating activities of the Staffing Office.

Duties

- 1. 24 hour responsibility in the following areas: ensuring staff coverage through appropriate staff scheduling
- 2. ensuring that staff skills, competencies and educational needs are met
- 3. Developing and interpreting departmental policy and procedures
- 4. Acting as liaison between department Medical Director, Vice President of Nursing, Administration and staff
- 5. Providing on going quality improvement monitors to ensure quality of patient care

- 1. Graduate of an accredited school of professional nursing and licensed to practice as a registered nurse in the State of California
- 2. BSN preferred
- 3. Experience as a charge nurse for at least two years
- 4. Demonstrated management experience
