# <u>Reports To</u>

### Job Summary

To assure effective cleanliness of the department and to maintain adequate inventory of supplies pertinent to the departmental operation.

### **Duties**

- 1. Maintain linen supply
  - a. Include adequately stocked warming cabinet
- 2. Maintain appropriate departmental supplies as available from Oroville Hospital storeroom.
- 3. Routine cleaning:
  - a. Dust all horizontal surfaces with hospital approved disinfectant daily and between surgical procedures
  - b. Mop Operating Room floors with hospital approved disinfectant daily and between surgical procedures
  - c. Dispose of contaminated linen and trash appropriately
  - d. Provide clean receptacles for linen and trash disposal in all areas of department at all times
  - e. Keep rooms and hallways clear of surplus equipment and/or furniture
  - f. Maintain scrub sinks clean and stocked
  - g. Maintain lounges, conference rooms in orderly fashion
  - h. Damp dust anesthesia equipment daily with hospital approved disinfectant
  - i. Maintain clean and functional suction receptacles
  - j. Keep walls and cabinets free of soil
  - k. Damp dust surgical lights daily and between surgical procedures
  - 1. Leave operating beds and gurneys covered with clean linen after cleaning
  - m. Safety straps and stirrup straps are to be clean at all times.
  - n. Damp dust auto claves daily with hospital approved disinfectant
- 4. Prepare designated surgical suite for Total Joint Arthroplasty using established procedure

- 5. Provide furniture and equipment pertinent to scheduled surgical procedure to surgical suite
- 6. Remove sterile supplies from Central Sterile shelves prior to "sterility" outdate
- 7. Transport patients to surgery and other hospital departments as needed
- 8. Participate in week-end call rotation
- 9. Maintain adequate level of dietary supplies
- 10. Report damaged equipment to Clinical Supervisor of Surgery immediately
- 11. Wear designated surgical attire
- 12. Assume additional duties as may be assigned

# **Qualifications**

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent
- 2. Current BLS certification

- 4. Knowledge of patient care equipment and supplies
