Job Summary

Responsible for preparing for surgical procedures as assigned and overseeing and assisting in smooth functioning of the operating team so as to assure optimum care of the patient.

Duties

- 1. Provides nursing care to all patients of all ages
- 2. Conducts an initial and ongoing assessment designed to gather data relevant to the patient's individual needs and age group
- 3. Scrub or circulate as assigned
- 4. Help in the work area
- 5. Help in keeping overall Operating Room clean and tidy
- 6. Report on and off duty at the control desk
- 7. Report on and off duty at the control desk for lunch
- 8. Inform control desk where you are at all times while on duty
- 9. Make sure room is cleaned, straightened and stocked before going off duty
- 10. When free:
 - a. Help in rooms by opening cases or helping with stocking
- 11. When case finishes early:
 - a. Help in rooms
- 12. Proper telephone and intercom etiquette
- 13. Knowledge and proper use of Surgery Department equipment and instrumentation
- 14. Proper use of time cards
- 15. Check bulletin board daily for notices and schedule change
- 16. Remain with patient while on O.R. table; never leave patient alone
- 17. Keep abreast of new changes occurring in the Surgery Department
- 18. Keep abreast of new techniques and procedures
- 19. Understand and perform standardization of set-ups

- 20. Economical use of supplies
- 21. Knowledge of handling and care of surgical instruments
- 22. Knowledge of fire and disaster procedure
- 23. Knowledge of cardiac arrest procedures. Must possess a basic and/or advanced CPR card
- 24. Know location of fire alarms, fire extinguishers and fire hoses
- 25. Be responsible for proper sponge, needle and instrument counts
- 26. Be constantly aware of proper aseptic technique and observe for any breaks in same
- 27. Be responsible for keeping records of operative procedure
- 28. Be responsible for all specimens and their proper labeling
- 29. Transport and check all blood for transfusions from lab
- 30. Takes O.R. call as scheduled
- 31. Participate in unit meetings and educational activities in order to develop skills and grow in awareness

- 3. Current BLS
- 4. RN certification in Medical/Surgical recommended
