Job Summary

To ensure all appropriate supplies and equipment are inventoried, received and distributed in accordance with proper and prudent practices.

Duties

- 1. In conjunction with departments, determine and update appropriate par levels for stock and non-stock supplies
- 2. Inventory appropriate departments, which will in turn generate both stock and non-stock requisitions
- 3. Pick and deliver stock orders from storeroom inventory on a timely basis
- 4. Deliver and shelf stock and non-stock supplies and equipment in a neat, orderly manner
- 5. Receive and deliver and/or shelf all incoming shipments, ensuring accuracy of shipments, noting damage or shortages
- 6. Responsible for shipment of outgoing supplies, including returns with proper packaging and insurance
- 7. Route packing slips to appropriate personnel
- 8. Keeps the storeroom, staging and dock areas clean and orderly at all times
- 9. Establish and maintain a good professional rapport with the medical staff, administration, nursing personnel, staff for patient care areas, and members of all other hospital departments and services
- 10. Adheres to the appropriate and necessary fiduciary, ethical and professional tone of the corporate purchasing function, both intra and inter departmental
- 11. Meet or exceed standards of compliance of all the accreditation and regulatory bodies and commissions, in relationship to the purchasing function
- 12. Under the supervision of the Director of Purchasing, coordinates the duties of the Inventory Clerk
- 13. Performs other related duties as may be assigned by the Director of Purchasing

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Qualifications

- 1. A minimum of at least a high school diploma
- 2. Two years work experience
- 3. Ability to follow written and oral instructions, read and write and basic math
- 4. Storeroom experience desirable

Lifting Requirements

The work environment is that of a busy and active storeroom with many time demands to be met. The lifting of 75 pounds maximum with frequent lifting and/or carrying of objects weighing up to 25 pounds is possible. Walking or standing is required to a significant degree.
